SALZBURG

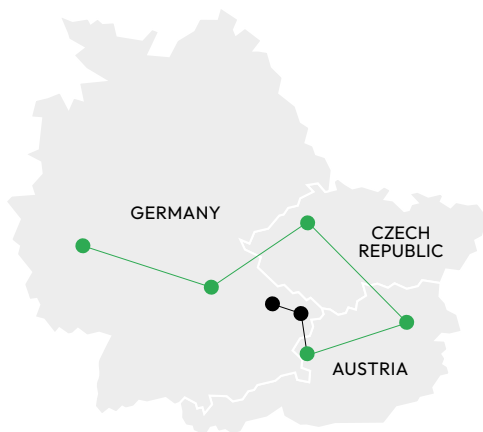
The city surrounds Beethoven lovers with musical splendour—historic halls, alpine grace, and a world-class concert culture that continues to welcome Beethoven to its stages.

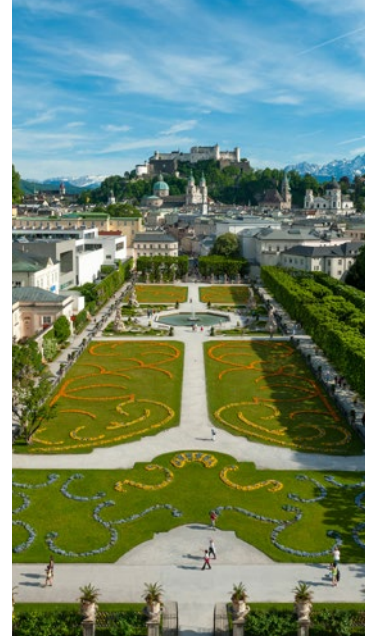
